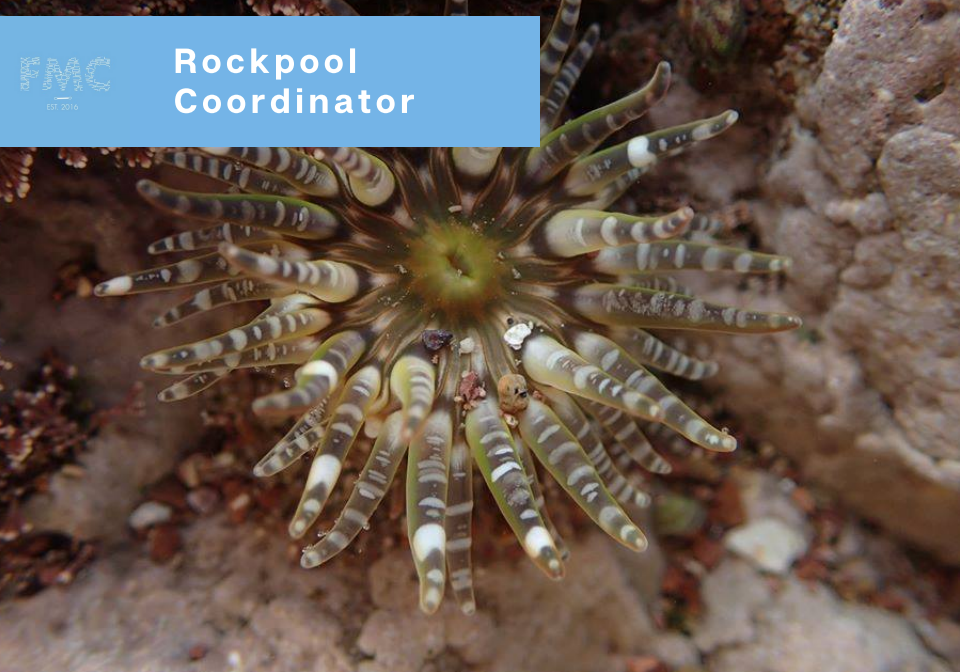


Rockpool Coordinator

- Be comfortable with public speaking in front of large groups of a variety of ages/from a variety of backgrounds
- Have a general awareness of ocean safety, eg understand tide times and beach flags
- Additional marine ID outside of rockpools is beneficial
- Be able to attend regular FMC meetings (must be based in Cornwall)
